


## Santee Fire Department Guidelines

## **Auto Turn Data: Fire Engine**

This design apparatus, along with data points, shall be used as the basis for roadway and parking lot geometries.



## Notes:

- A Santee Fire Department Maneuverability Analysis shall be performed by a licensed professional engineer to verify the turning capabilities of this design apparatus. Travel paths should begin outside the site illustrating the turn onto all entry roads/drives, maneuvering around the site, and completed with an illustration demonstrating exiting from the site.
- 2. Paths must illustrate the full vehicle swept path (including wheel tracks and wall-to-wall vehicle overhang sweep) and must indicate a clear, unobstructed travel around the site without impact/collisions to building, curbs, landscaping, parking spaces, vehicles, etc. Wheel tracks shall not come within 1 foot of curbs. Apparatus bumper overhang shall not extend over curbs and the like.
- 3. Design speed (no less than 5 mph); if speed varies indicate points of change and notes/labels.
- 4. The Santee Fire Department Maneuverability Analysis shall be used to create an exhibit, which shall be submitted for review and approval.
- 5. Maneuverability Analysis shall also be designed to and confirm that any angle of approach/departure does not exceed 7° (degrees).
- 6. This detail shall be reproduced on the submitted exhibit.
