**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

Notice is hereby given that the public agency named below has completed an Initial Study of the following described project at the following location:	
Public Agency:	City of Santee
Project Name:	Rockvill Street Warehouse
Project Description:	<p>Applications for a Development Review Permit (DR2022-1) and Environmental Initial Study (AEIS2022-2) for the development of the Rockvill Street Warehouse Project (project). The project involves the construction of an approximately 24,631-square-foot building for general commercial/light industrial uses. The subject property is located at 10756 Rockvill Street on a 2.08-acre parcel (Assessor’s Parcel Number 384-470-09).</p> <p>The proposed project would also include 51 parking spaces, a staging and loading area, drive lanes, and an approximately 15-foot-high crib wall along the east side of the lot. Vehicular access into the subject property would be provided via Rockvill Street. Major roadways which lead to Rockvill Street include Mission Gorge Road and North Magnolia Avenue.</p> <p>Project Applicant: Southwest Signal; Ryan Clark Project Planner: Douglas Thomsen</p>
