Event Reminders:

- The footbridges in Town Center Community Park West and by the YMCA will be open for access to the event.
- Town Center Community Park East will close shortly after the conclusion of the fireworks.
- City of Santee special events are for the enjoyment of all attendees. The city reserves the right to take all steps necessary to ensure the safety, security and reduce risk to the public.
- Entry into the event is subject to park capacity limits.

How much does it cost to participate in Santee Salutes?

Santee Salutes is a free event. However, there is a nominal fee for reserved parking, optional food and drinks, onsite vendors selling glow necklaces, face painting and t-shirts.

Where are the restrooms located?

Permanent restrooms are located at the Northwest side of the park in the permanent building by Riverwalk Grill. Porta-potty banks are located at the Southeast side of the park.

Where will the band be playing? Can I bring chairs or a blanket?

The band will be playing on the main stage adjacent to the parking lot. The band will not play after the fireworks show. The venue is set up for lawn and picnic-style seating. Remember to bring your chairs and blankets. Canopies and umbrellas are allowed behind the designated canopy line indicated on the field. Canopies must be sandbagged or weighted down; stakes are not allowed. Seating is first-come, first-served. All canopies and umbrellas in the park need to be taken down at dusk to prevent obstructing the view of the fireworks.

Can I bring my dog?

Yes, dogs are welcome at the event if they are well-behaved, on a leash no longer than 6 ft and you have doggie waste bags on hand. Please make sure your dog is secured during the firework show. The lights will be turned off on the field and the fireworks will be loud. This can be very frightening to animals, including dogs.

Is this a rain or shine event?

Yes, the event will be held rain or shine. The City of Santee may cancel the event due to dangerous weather conditions

Fireworks Show:

The fireworks show with choreographed music will begin around 9:00 PM. The soundtrack will also be played live on SanteeTV at 9:00 PM. You can find SanteeTV on the City of Santee's website.

Will there be more than one firework show this year?

No; the only firework show will be in Town Center Community Park East on July 4th at 9 PM.

Is there a simulcast?

No; however, SanteeTV will broadcast a live soundtrack. Visit the City of Santee's website.

What should I wear/bring?

It will be warm/hot when the event begins but the tempreature cools down in the evening a light jacket is recommended. Surrounding areas are sprayed for mosquitos. We suggest bringing bug repellent, sunscreen and water. Candles are prohibited including bug citronella candles.



Parking

Advance reserved parking in the surrounding lots is by online advance **ONLY** purchase at SanteeSpecialEvents.com while supplies last. Limited street and business parking may be available in the surrounding areas, all parking must be legal and compliant with all posted signage. Biking, walking and ride-share are strongly encouraged. We will also offer a free shuttle to and from Costco from 3:00 PM - 11:00 PM. The last pick up from Costco to the event will be at 8:30 PM.

Unloading and Loading Zones:

Loading/unloading zone and ride-share dropoff is located at the front of the YMCA parking lot, the remainder of the lot is reserved parking.
