Update on Curfew Orders for the City of Santee for Saturday, June 6 and Sunday, June 7, 2020

Based on a review of the large gatherings and incidents that have occurred this past week in the City of Santee, the City has implemented an update to the curfew orders as follows:

- For Saturday, June 6, 2020, a curfew order has **not** been issued. However, if credible evidence of a specific and imminent risk to public health and safety occurs, an emergency curfew will be issued and planned to commence at 9:30 p.m. and extend to June 7, 2020 at 6 a.m. The curfew zone would cover the commercial area described as follows: south of Mast Boulevard, east of Carlton Hills Boulevard, west of Magnolia Avenue, and north of Highway 52.
- For Sunday, June 7, 2020, a curfew order has been issued and is in effect from June 7, 2020 at 7 p.m. until June 8, 2020 at 6 a.m. for the portions of Santee located to the west of Magnolia Avenue (including all of Magnolia Avenue itself), extending to the westerly boundary of the City of Santee.
